

Statement pursuant to Section 54(6) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015

Connect Health Group Limited and its subsidiaries are providers of healthcare services and solutions to the NHS and the private sector. We are fully aware of our responsibilities to our patients, colleagues, and service users, and have a zero tolerance towards acts of human trafficking and modern slavery which are unlawful or are a violation of human rights. We assess the risk of modern slavery or human trafficking playing a part in our business as very low.

Our business is United Kingdom based and our 850 employees have all undertaken mandatory training on this subject and we expect all employees to be alert for and report any concerns about slavery and/or human trafficking. We have an Anti-Slavery policy in place.

Our Assurance

In order to mitigate the risks in our business and supply chain we:

- Complete thorough and appropriate pre-employment checks on all our employees and require all agencies we use to do the same, we regularly audit both internal and external processes.
- Ensure all of our employment practices, comply with all relevant laws and regulations and respect Equality, Diversity and Human Rights
- Provide modern slavery training through our induction process and ongoing refresher training for all colleagues.
- Have robust training, processes and policies relating to the safeguarding of children and adults.
- Only trade with suppliers who share our values and hold ethics and sustainability as essential prerequisites.
- Assess each new prospective supplier as part of our prequalification questionnaire which asks prospective suppliers to explicitly confirm their adherence to the Modern Slavery Act 2015.
- Maintain a detailed procurement policy which sets out the framework and approval levels for selecting suppliers to work with, assessing them on items such as CSR, ISO9001 and Information Governance.
- Undertake periodic supplier appraisals of existing suppliers to assess their performance against contract SLAs, quality, and compliance to gain assurance that they continue to be a valued partner.
